The Langhorne Creek region, located south of Australia, is renowned for producing full-fruited red wines with gentle tannins.

WINEMAKING

The fruit was crushed and fermented at our winery in Pokolbin in March 2006. After fermentation, the wine was matured in small French oak barrels before being bottled in June 2008.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES – Usher Tinkler

Deep red to black in colour, the wine has lifted blackberry, dark chocolate and mint aromas. Ripe blueberry and mocha flavours can be found on the palate supported by soft vanillin oak.

This is a rich, concentrated cabernet sauvignon, which will continue to improve for up to 15 years if cellared in optimum conditions.

It complements seared venison, braised beef cheeks or aged parmesan.
